Literacy

In Literacy we have written a description of a scene and throughout this term we will focus on writing recounts, letters and a setting description. In recount writing we will focus our grammar around the use of simple past tense, time conjunctions and emotive language. When writing letters, we will develop our understanding of relative clauses and formality. When writing setting descriptions, we will improve our knowledge of the use of parentheses (brackets, dashes, commas).

Numeracy

In Place Value Year 6 will be identifying, reading and writing numbers to 10,000,000, understanding powers of 10, using number lines to and rounding. In addition, subtraction and multiplication they will cover: adding and subtracting integers, common factors and common multiples, rules of divisibility, primes to 100, square and cube numbers, multiplying up to a 4-digit number by a 2-digit number, solving problems with multiplication.

Topic

In **Geography** this half term Year 6 will study The Seven Continents with a focus on Antarctica. The class will focus in the physical geography of Antarctica as a polar region and use map skills for a geographical investigation. Finally, the class will study the Human Geography of the region (daily life in Antarctica environments) with a focus on Shackleton's expedition and its challenges.

Literacy texts will include: Shackleton's Journey, A Trip to the Bottom of the World, The Emperor's Egg, Mega Meltdown
